BLAWNOX COMMUNITY SPORTS ASSOCIATION PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT POLICY 2019

It is the intention of this compact to promote Fair Play and Respect for all Participants within Blawnox Baseball/Softball. It is expected that all parents/caregivers of Blawnox Baseball/Softball participants read and understand the Parent Code of Conduct and continue to observe and follow all the principles contained within the Code throughout the year.

- a. I will not force my child to participate baseball/softball. I will try to make it FUN!
- b. I will encourage my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflict without resorting to hostility or violence.
- c. I will teach my child that doing one's best is as important as winning so that my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of the game. I will make my child feel like a winner every time by offering praise for competing fairly and hard.
- d. I will never ridicule or yell at my child for making a mistake or losing a game.
- e. I will remember that children learn by example. I will applaud good plays by both my child's team and their opponents. I will not be critical of, or embarrass any player, including opposition players.
- f. I will never question the official's judgment or honesty in public. I recognize that officials are being developed in the same manner as players.
- g. I will respect and show appreciation for the volunteers who give their time to baseball/softball for my child.
- h. I will never yell, taunt, threaten or inflict physical violence upon any player, coach, official or spectator at any youth baseball/softball activity. I will refrain from the use of abusive or vulgar language, racial, ethnic or gender-related slurs at any time during any youth baseball/softball function. I will support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from youth baseball/softball games.
- i. I will leave the coaching to the coaching staff. I will encourage my child to play in a manner consistent with the team's strategy or plans.
- j. I will emphasize skill development and a serious approach to practices and explain how skill development will benefit my child.
- k. I will attempt to learn about the game of baseball/softball so that I may best support my child's development in the game.
- l. I will communicate all and any concerns regarding inappropriate behavior to the Board of Directors, Coach, or Assistant Coach.
- m. I will insist that my child plays in a safe and healthy environment. I will support a sports environment that is free of alcohol, drugs or tobacco and I will refrain from their use at all youth sports events.
- n. I understand the benefits from participating in a team sport, the commitment, the discipline and the social skills learned and acquired.
- o. I will remember that my child plays baseball/softball for his or her enjoyment, not mine.
